Application Instructions

We are pleased that you are interested in applying to Temple University Beasley School of Law. This application is for students who are currently attending another law school and want to either transfer to Temple Law School or visit Temple Law School for their final year.

It is important that you read this information carefully prior to completing and forwarding your application. We urge you to give us your most complete and thoughtfully prepared responses to all questions on the application.

Transfer Applicants

Temple Law School accepts a limited number of transfer students from law schools which are approved by the American Bar Association (ABA) and are members of the Association of American Law Schools (AALS). Since applicants must have completed a full year of law school before their application can be considered, transfer decisions are typically not made before mid-July.

Transfer applicants must submit the following by the transfer application deadline of June 15, 2019:

- * Completed application form and \$65 application fee;
- * Personal statement outlining your reasons for applying to transfer to Temple Law School;

* A letter from the applicant's current law school certifying that the applicant has completed the first year, is in good standing, and is eligible to continue her studies;

* Official transcript from the applicant's current law school showing grades for all completed work (to be sent after receipt of grades for all first year courses);

* A letter or other official document indicating the applicant's class rank at the end of the first year (to be sent after receipt of grades for all first year courses);

* A Credential Assembly Report (CAS). The CAS report may be sent to Temple Law School from LSAC, or the applicant may have a copy of the first page of the CAS report sent to Temple from their current law school. A copy of the CAS report may already on file with the Admissions Office if the applicant has previously applied to Temple Law for admission as a first year student.

Visiting Applicants (non-matriculating)

Students enrolled at another ABA accredited and AALS member law school may apply to take courses at Temple Law School for their FINAL year of law school. Visiting students receive their J.D. degree from their home law school. Applicants for visiting status must submit grades including their most recent course work, typically the spring semester, and decisions on visiting applicants are generally not made before mid-July.

Visiting applicants must submit the following by the visiting status application deadline of June 15, 2019:

- * Completed application form and \$65 application fee;
- * Personal statement outlining your reasons for seeking visiting student status at Temple Law School;

* A letter from the applicant's current law school indicating that they have permission to visit Temple Law School and that the school will accept all course work successfully completed at Temple Law School;

* Official transcript from the applicant's current law school showing grades for all completed work;

* A Credential Assembly Report (CAS). The CAS report may be sent to Temple Law School from LSAC, or the applicant may have a copy of the first page of the report sent to Temple from their current law school. Temple may have a copy of the CAS report already on file if the applicant has previously applied to Temple Law for admission as a first year student.

The application form must be completed and mailed to Temple or electronically transmitted to LSAC on or before June 15, 2019.

* If you elect to pay your application fee by credit card, your payment can be sent directly to LSAC at the time you submit your electronic application. At that time you will also have the option of submitting your signature electronically via LSAC.

* If you elect to pay your application fee using a method other than payment by credit card via LSAC, you must forward the application fee along with your signed Certification Letter directly to the Law School Office of Admissions at the address listed above.

Character and Fitness

It is imperative that the questions in the Character & Fitness section on the application be answered fully. Because of the high ethical standards to which lawyers are held, the failure to disclose academic or disciplinary action, criminal convictions or pending criminal charges, is often more significant, and can lead to more serious consequences, than the action, conviction or charge itself.

If in doubt as to whether or not to disclose a particular incident, we recommend that you err on the side of disclosure. If the record has been expunged or sealed, you are encouraged to disclose the information. In addition to a bar examination, there are character, fitness, and other qualifications for admission to the bar in every U.S. jurisdiction. Many states require expunged or sealed records to be disclosed on an application for admission to the bar and will inquire as to what information an applicant has disclosed to their law school. Inconsistencies or discrepancies in the information could serve as a barrier for admission to the bar.

Applicants are encouraged to determine the requirements for any jurisdiction in which they intend to seek admission by contacting the jurisdiction. Addresses for all relevant agencies are available through the National Conference of Bar Examiners.
