Canine Body Map

This map is meant to help record and monitor masses and changes on your dog's body. Please follow the directions and bring this to each appointment or e-mail a picture of the page so it can be scanned into your pet's medical record.

- Find the mass and put a small circled number on the location on your dog on this page
- Use a set of calipers (special measuring device), or small centimeter ruler
- Grab the area between your fingers so you can identify the mass apart from excess skin/hair and measure. If mostly circular, you can measure one diameter, if more oval, then measure the length and width
- On the lines below, write the corresponding number, then list the measurement and description (for example: soft, firm, non-moveable, freely moveable, hairless, bleeding, red, etc)
