ANY major may follow the above list of courses. All courses must be completed with a C- or better. Additional courses will need to be taken at CSUF. Students majoring in Liberal Studies will meet the subject matter requirement and can choose any CSU GE course, Liberal Studies, B.A.

CDES 261 F (*equivalent to CSUF EDEL 315*) is recommended for early field work experience. Field work is a requirement for admission into CSU Fullerton's teaching credential program.

Students can fulfill the Basic Skills Requirement by completing a course in Area A2 (English proficiency), A3 (Reading proficiency) and B4 (Math proficiency) with a B- or better.

In order to obtain a multiple subject teaching credential in the state of California all students must prove they meet the Basic Skills Requirement and Subject Matter Competency. It is important that students meet with a counselor to discuss their options to fulfill these requirements.

Note: Courses in Areas A1, A2 and A3 are not part of the CSET Multiple Subjects Subtest 1 Coursework Option to Satisfy Subject Matter Competency for the Education Specialist or Multiple Subject Credential Programs.
