CDES 261 F (equivalent to CSUF EDEL 315) is recommended for early field work experience. Field work is a requirement for admission into CSU Fullerton's teaching credential program.

Students can fulfill the Basic Skills Requirement by completing a course in Area A2 (English proficiency), A3 (Reading proficiency) and B4 (Math proficiency) with a B- or better.

In order to obtain a multiple subject teaching credential in the state of California all students must prove they meet the Basic Skills Requirement and Subject Matter Competency. It is important that students meet with a counselor to discuss their options to fulfill these requirements.

Note: Courses in Areas A1, A2 and A3 are not part of the CSET Multiple Subjects Subtest 1 Coursework Option to Satisfy Subject Matter Competency for the Education Specialist or Multiple Subject Credential Programs.
