The Physician Assistant (PA) Program at Radford University is accredited by the AR students to sit for the Physician Assistant National Certifying Examination (PANCE) Certification of Physician Assistants (NCCPA). All states require that an initial licen will need to meet the mental, physical, and ethical requirements/attestations for ϵ checks; and sponsoring physicians and/or institutions, practice agreements, and ethication of any disciplinary action will be requested. Upon licensure, PAs will b medical education and NCCPA certification. DEA licensure is a separate application with additional requirements for prescriptive authority imposed by some states.
