- 2. Receive an admission letter from Shoreline Community College, as well as a conditional guaranteed admission letter to the University of Iowa AT THE SAME TIME!
- 3. Take your admission letters, along with your I-20 document, to the U.S. embassy or consulate and apply for your F-1 visa.
- 4. Enroll at Shoreline and finish the first half of your bachelor's degree by earning an A.A. or A.S. degree.
- 5. Transfer to the University of Iowa to finish the second half of your bachelor's degree.
- 6. Complete your bachelor's degree from the University of Iowa!

Conditional Guaranteed Transfer Admission to the University of Iowa Requires:

- Earn an A.A. or A.S. degree from Shoreline Community College or complete a minimum of 36 transferable quarter credits by the time of transfer;
- Maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of at least 2.50;
- Meet the University of Iowa's English proficiency requirements;
- Submit a completed application and all necessary documentation to the University of Iowa by the application deadline for the intended transfer term.
- NOTE: This agreement is valid for admission to the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences. Other colleges, or selective, competitive majors within the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, may have higher GPA requirements and/or prerequisite courses required for admission.
